## Second Quarter 1998 Shows Bankruptcy Filings Still Surging

A report released today by the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts shows that for the eighth consecutive 12-month period, the number of cases filed in U.S. bankruptcy courts reached an all-time high, lending support to the acute need to establish new bankruptcy judgeships.

The number of bankruptcy petitions filed in the twelve-month period ending March 31, 1998, was up 14 percent over the same 12-month period ending March 31, 1997. Filings in the twelve-month period ending March 31, 1998 totaled 1,423,128, the eighth consecutive time filings for a 12-month period hit a record-high. The number of bankruptcies filed during the second quarter of fiscal year 1998 (January 1, 1998-March 31, 1998) was 354,118, a 6 percent increase over the second quarter of FY97 (January 1, 1997-March 31, 1997) when filings totaled 335,073.

Faced with an ever-increasing bankruptcy caseload, the Judiciary asked Congress in 1997 for new bankruptcy judgeships. New bankruptcy judgeships were last created in 1992. Last week, the Senate Judiciary Committee approved S. 1301, the Consumer Bankruptcy Reform Act of 1997, which would create 18 temporary bankruptcy judgeships, in addition to substantially reforming the bankruptcy system. A House bill, H.R. 1596, the Bankruptcy Judgeship Act of 1997, passed in the first session of the 105th Congress, and would authorize seven new permanent bankruptcy judgeships and 11 temporary judgeships.

### Bankruptcy Filings in the District Courts

Among the U.S. bankruptcy courts, the Central District of California remained the district reporting the largest number of filings—119,230—for the 12-month period ending March 31, 1998. This is a 10 percent increase over the 12-month period ending March 31, 1997, when a total of 108,031 bankruptcy cases were filed in the Central District of California.

For the 12-month period ending March 31, 1998, several districts reported bankruptcy filings in excess of  
(MORE)

40,000. These districts are the Districts of New Jersey, Illinois-Northern, and Florida-Middle. Several districts report filings over 30,000. These districts are the Districts of New York-Eastern, Maryland, Virginia-Eastern, California-Northern, California-Eastern, and Georgia-Northern. Only two districts reported a decline in filings in this period: the District Court for the Northern Mariana Islands and the Southern District of Alabama.

**Filings by Chapter**

Of the total number of bankruptcy filings for the 12-month period ending March 31, 1998, there were 1,007,213 Chapter 7 filings, an increase of 17 percent over the 862,136 filings in the same period in 1997. The next largest group of filings were Chapter 13 filings at 404,749, a 9 percent increase over the 372,369 filings in the same 12-month period in 1997. Chapter 11 filings dropped to 10,244 in the 12-month period ending March 31, 1998, down from 11,472 in 1997. Chapter 12 filings also fell in this period, from 1,050 in 1997 to 880 in 1998. Business filings totaled 52,638. Non-business filings totaled 1,370,490, up 15 percent from the total non-business filings of 1,193,057 in the 12-month period ending March 31, 1997.

Chapter 7 is designed to allow individuals to keep certain exempt property while the remaining property is sold to repay creditors. Under Chapter 13 bankruptcy, creditors may be repaid in installments, in full or in part, over a 3- to 5-year period. Chapter 11 provides for a business to continue operations while formulating a plan to repay its creditors. Chapter 12 is designed to meet the needs of financially distressed family farmers.
