Dear Mr. Tighe,

I hereby petition the Judicial Council for review of the order dated December 18, 2018, wherein Chief Circuit Judge Timothy M. Tymkovich acting on behalf of the Judicial Council dismissed my complaint concerning Brett M. Kavanaugh for the following reasons:

- 1. 28 U.S.C. 351 *et seq.* applies to a judge that performs judicial duties when the misconduct occurs;
- 2. elevation to the Supreme Court of the United States of a judge who engaged in misconduct should not be consider an intervening act;
- the Judicial Council should interpret 28 U.S.C. 351 et seq. in a manner that restores the public's confidence in a judiciary free of bias and partisan politics;
- 4. each of the members of the Judicial Council owe a duty to the American public to sanction in the harshest terms the misconduct of this judge.

The Judicial Council's failure to sanction confirms what many citizen's believe is an effort to protect this jurist.
