The growth in civil filings in 2004 resulted from a 16 percent increase in federal guestion cases; approximately 20,000 of those filings related to one case in the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of South Carolina. In addition, diversity of citizenship filings rose significantly due to a 58 percent increase in personal injury product liability filings.
