I note in the material speaking to Rule there are incorporated in substance some of my suggestions previously submitted although I know many others no dobut submitted similar suggestions.

With reference to the preliminary draft received today I studied my file reflecting my earlier analyses. I have only the following observatiosn with respect to the maerial which came with your letter of August 31st:

As to Rule 4002, the purport is Well put. The things a debtor must submit are well taken. My only suggestion is that it might be supported to add a sentence requiring, the debter also to submit a verified full financial statement.

Looking to Rule 404, the thrust of the Rule is well supported. Character evidence undr the situation postulated

shouild not be admissible. May it not be correct, however, to enlarge the rule slightly by stating an exception exists if the case involves the element of the person's character as, for instance, if the case has to do with the person's having stated falsely relevant information and this false statement concerns an aspect at issue in the case?
