

RE: Comments on the Preliminary Draft of Proposed Amendments to Criminal Procedure Rule 5 and Federal Rule of Evidence 408

With regard to proposed changes to Rule 5, Fed.R.Crim.P., <u>Initial Appearance</u>:

The Rule should make clear that non-certified photocopies are not the equivalent of "reliable electronic means."

With regard to proposed changes to Rule 408, Fed.R.Evid., <u>Compromise and Offers of Compromise</u>:

It should be made clear within the context of the Rule itself that statements made by a representative or agent of a party in an attempt to settle a claim are never admissible against the party in any context, civil or criminal.
