She suggested I notify the Rules Committee that the vast majority of non-individual debtors across the country since December 1, 2015 have not answered Question 7 of Bankruptcy Official Form 201. As you are aware, Question 7 requires non-individual debtors to list the 4-digit NACIS Code that best describes their business (source: <a href="http://www.uscourts.gov/four-digit-national-association-naics-codes">http://www.uscourts.gov/four-digit-national-association-naics-codes</a>), yet over 75% of the filers have left that question unanswered.

I hope the Rules Committee will take appropriate action to remedy this situation.
