

Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990

Report of Motions Pending More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted More Than Six Months, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months, Social Security Appeal Cases Pending More Than Six Months, and Civil Cases Pending More Than Three Years on September 30, 2014

Introduction

The Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990 (CJRA) requires the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts (AO), under 28 U.S.C. § 476, to prepare a semiannual report showing, by U.S. district judge and U.S. magistrate judge, all motions pending more than six months, all bench trials that have remained undecided more than six months, and all civil cases pending more than three years. In accordance with the policy of the Judicial Conference of the United States, this report also presents data on bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months (Rpt. of Proc. of JCUS, Mar. 10, 1998, at 11) and Social Security appeals pending more than six months (Rpt. of Proc. of JCUS, Sept. 15, 1998, at 63). The reporting requirements under the CJRA are designed to help reduce both costs and delays in civil litigation in the district courts. The information also may be used to evaluate demands on the district courts' resources.

The CJRA report is prepared through the use of the Case Management/Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) system. As a result, pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeals are reported in a standardized and consistent fashion.

Appendix A provides data for each district judge and magistrate judge on motions pending, bench trials submitted, cases pending more than three years, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeals pending. The CJRA requires the AO Director to establish uniform standards for determining when a motion, bench trial, case, or bankruptcy appeal is “pending”; Appendix B lists these definitions.

Along with the semiannual consolidated national report, the AO prepares a supplemental report, *A Report on Motions Pending for More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted for More Than Six Months, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending for More Than Six Months, Social Security Appeals Pending for More Than Six Months, and Civil Cases Pending Three Years or More*, that provides detailed information regarding the individual cases, motions, bench trials, and appeals pending in the district courts. This document is available to the public through the district courts, the executive offices of the U.S. courts of appeals, the AO, and the Federal Judiciary website www.uscourts.gov.

Report Findings

The information in this report presents what may best be described as a “snapshot” of motions pending more than six months, bench trials submitted more than six months, civil cases pending more than three years, bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months, and Social Security appeals pending more than six months on

September 30, 2014. District judge and magistrate judge caseloads change constantly, so many of the matters pending on September 30, 2014, have since been decided or transferred to other judges. Therefore, persons using this report should take into account the state of change in the district courts' pending caseloads.

Although the information provided in this report pertains to the pending civil caseload of district judges and magistrate judges, readers should take into consideration the overall case processing demands placed on the courts by both civil and criminal matters. An accurate assessment of the demands placed on the district courts also requires consideration of numerous factors, including vacant judgeships and the effects of all cases making up each court's caseload.

Methodology

This national report is designed to place special emphasis on detailed analyses that are extracted from the national CM/ECF system. Each district court is required to analyze the reasons for delays in disposing of motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeals. Judges use status codes to provide reasons for delays in these matters (see Appendix C). The nature of suit codes for types of civil litigation appear in Appendix D. More specific information about cases pending, motions pending, bench trials submitted, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeals pending on March 31, 2014, and September 30, 2014, appears in the Tables 1-4.

Numbers of Motions Pending, Bench Trials Submitted, Civil Cases Pending, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending, and Social Security Appeals Pending on September 30, 2014.

Motions. The total number of motions pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges declined 7 percent (down 388 motions) from 5,515 on March 31, 2014, to 5,127 on September 30, 2014. Ninety-two percent of all motions pending were before district judges, and 8 percent were before magistrate judges.

For the September 30, 2014, CJRA report, nine circuits reported decreases in pending motions, and three circuits reported increases. The most substantial reductions in pending motions occurred in the Third Circuit (down 121 motions), Fifth Circuit (down 111 motions), and Ninth Circuit (down 70 motions). In the Third Circuit, the District of Delaware reported 71 fewer motions in multiple types of civil cases. In the Fifth Circuit, seven of the nine district courts reported decreases in motions in many types of civil cases. In the Ninth Circuit, the District of Nevada reported 92 fewer motions in various types of civil cases.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Motions. District courts provided one or more status codes to indicate primary reasons for delays for each of the 5,127 pending motions reported for September 30, 2014. The status codes cited most often were opinion/decision in draft (1,686 motions), complexity of case (854 motions), voluminous briefs/transcripts to be read (608 motions), heavy criminal and civil caseload (531 motions), referred to magistrate judge (439 motions), and hearing on motion necessary (305 motions).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Motions. The primary nature of suit codes provided most often by district courts for pending motions were civil rights (1,263 motions), prisoner petitions (856 motions), contracts (745 motions), other statutory actions (361 motions), labor (334 motions), and intellectual property rights (325 motions).

Bench Trials. The total number of bench trials pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges fell by 7 to 72 trials. Seven of the 12 circuits reported declines in pending bench trials, 4 circuits had growth in pending bench trials, and the total for 1 circuit remained unchanged.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bench Trials. District courts provided one or more status codes to indicate the primary reasons for delays for each of the 72 pending bench trials reported for September 30, 2014. The status codes cited most often were opinion/decision in draft (47 trials) and complexity of case (18 trials).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Bench Trials. The primary nature of suit codes provided most often for pending bench trials were contract (20 trials), intellectual property rights (11 trials), labor (9 trials), civil rights (7 trials), and prisoner petitions (4 trials).

Civil Cases. The number of civil cases pending more than three years increased 7 percent (up 1,115 cases) from 17,128 on March 31, 2014, to 18,243 on September 30, 2014. District judges reported 98 percent of all pending three-year-old cases, and magistrate judges reported the remaining 2 percent. Three-year-old cases rose in 7 of the 12 circuits and dropped in 5 circuits. The most significant jumps occurred in the Sixth Circuit (up 1,341 cases), Seventh Circuit (up 111 cases), and Ninth Circuit (up 82 cases). In the Sixth Circuit, a single judge in the Northern District of Ohio reported 1,505 new three-year-old cases, most of which involved multidistrict litigation in personal injury cases related to hip replacements. In the Seventh Circuit a single judge in the Northern District of Illinois reported 69 new multidistrict litigation

cases alleging personal injury due to knee replacement devices. In the Ninth Circuit, the Southern District of California reported 82 additional three-year-old cases of multiple types.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Civil Cases. District courts provided one or more status codes to indicate reasons for delays for all 18,243 civil cases reported for September 30, 2014. The status codes cited most often were multidistrict litigation (10,821 cases), complexity of case (1,985 cases), referred to magistrate judge (1,005 cases), awaiting materials (893 cases), trial scheduled (876 cases), extensive discovery involved (798 cases), opinion/decision in draft (688 cases), settlement pending (634 cases), and set for status conference (513 cases).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes In Pending Civil Cases. The primary nature of suit codes given most often by district courts for pending civil cases were personal injury/product liability (9,439 cases), prisoner petitions (1,961 petitions), civil rights (1,373 cases), contract (894 cases), antitrust (519 cases), labor (398 cases), real property (360), intellectual property rights (333 cases), and securities/commodities/exchange (301 cases).

Bankruptcy Appeals. Bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months dropped 12 percent to 159 on September 30, 2014. All pending bankruptcy appeals were reported by district judges. Decreases occurred in 5 of the 12 circuits, increases occurred in 4 circuits, and totals remained unchanged in 3 circuits. Five circuits reported 74 percent of all pending bankruptcy appeals: the Third Circuit (36 appeals), Ninth Circuit (27 appeals), Fifth Circuit (22 appeals), Second Circuit (21 appeals), and Eleventh Circuit (12 appeals).

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bankruptcy Appeals. District courts provided one or more status codes to indicate reasons for delays for each of the 159 pending bankruptcy appeals reported for September 30, 2014. The status codes cited

most often were opinion/decision in draft (34 appeals), heavy criminal and civil caseload (30 appeals), complexity of case (26 appeals), voluminous briefs/transcripts to be read (26 appeals), and awaiting materials (18 appeals).

Social Security Appeals. Social Security appeals pending more than six months fell 21 percent (down 196 appeals) from 927 on March 31, 2014, to 731 on September 30, 2014. District judges reported 86 percent of these appeals; magistrate judges reported 14 percent. Seven of the 12 circuits had reductions, 4 had increases, and the total in 1 remained unchanged. The most significant decreases in pending Social Security appeals occurred in the Eleventh Circuit (down 92 appeals), Third Circuit (down 64 appeals), Eighth Circuit (down 49 appeals), and Seventh Circuit (down 35 appeals).

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Social Security Appeals. District courts provided one or more status codes to indicate reasons for delays for all 731 pending Social Security appeals reported for September 30, 2014. The status codes cited most often were referred to magistrate judge (258 appeals), opinion/decision in draft (152 appeals), voluminous briefs/transcripts to be read (100 appeals), heavy criminal and civil caseload (60 cases), recently received from magistrate judge on recommendation (40 cases), and recently received from the calendar of another judge (39 appeals).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Social Security Appeals. Ninety-six percent of the pending Social Security appeals (703 appeals) involved supplemental security income or disability insurance.

Appendix B. Definitions

All active and senior district court judges, as well as all full-time and part-time magistrate judges, must report pending matters. Several issues relevant to the reporting of cases pending for more than three years include the following.

- With respect to cases pending for more than three years that have been assigned to district judges and magistrate judges from outside the districts where the cases originated, such cases are included in the totals for the districts where they were filed originally. Sometimes a block of cases or a class of cases that are similar in nature is assigned to a single judge. Such cases often require lengthy litigation when they involve complex issues and large numbers of parties.
- This report includes some asbestos cases. The Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation (MDL) authorized the transfer of most of the pending asbestos personal injury/product liability cases to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania under Order Number 875. Asbestos cases that have remained in the districts where they were filed originally or that were transferred back to the original districts are included in this report. However, those cases transferred according to MDL Order Number 875 are excluded. All other MDL cases are included in this report.

Cases Pending More Than Three Years. The CJRA requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of cases pending more than three years in the district courts. A case becomes pending as of the date the case originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was reopened, whichever is later. If a case has not been disposed of within three years after its filing date or reopening date, the case shall be reported as pending more than three years.

Motions Pending More Than Six Months. The CJRA mandates a report enumerating all motions that have been pending six months or longer. A motion is a request made to a district judge or magistrate judge for an order, ruling, or similar determination. The opposing party has 30 days from the date of a motion's filing to respond to it. A motion becomes pending 30 days after the date it was filed or was referred to a magistrate judge, whichever is later. If no decision on a motion has been filed within six months after the date the motion became pending, and the motion has not been referred to a magistrate judge, the motion shall be reported as pending more than six months before the presiding judge. If a motion is referred to a magistrate judge, the magistrate judge must file a report and make a recommendation for, or dispose of, the motion within six months after the date the motion became pending, or the motion shall be reported as pending for both the district judge and the magistrate judge.

Bench Trials Submitted More than Six Months. The CJRA requires the AO to prepare a report of bench trials submitted more than six months. In a bench trial, the judge (rather than a jury) decides the facts of the case. A bench trial is considered to be submitted on the date the courtroom proceedings are concluded. If a judge fails to file an opinion within six months after a bench trial was submitted, the bench trial shall be reported as submitted more than six months.

Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months. In accordance with an action of the March 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months in the district courts. A bankruptcy appeal becomes pending as of the date the appeal originally was filed in the district

court or the date the case was reopened, whichever is later. If an appeal has not been disposed of within six months plus 60 days after its filing date or reopening date, the appeal shall be reported as pending more than six months.

Social Security Appeals Pending More Than Six Months. In accordance with an action of the September 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months in the district courts. A Social Security appeal case becomes pending as of the date of the filing of the latest transcript in such case. If a case has not been disposed of within six months plus 120 days after its filing date, the case shall be reported as pending more than six months.
