

Process for Filing a Judicial Conduct or Disability Complaint *

complainant files complaint (Rule 6)

circuit chief judge reviews complaint (Rule 11)

circuit chief judge issues order dismissing or concluding complaint (Rule 11(c)-(e))

circuit chief judge appoints special committee (Rule 11(f))

complainant or subject judge may petition for judicial council review (Rule 18)

special committee files report with judicial council (Rule 17)

judicial council issues order on petition for review (Rule 19)

judicial council considers special committee report and issues order (Rule 20)

complainant or subject judge may petition for review by Committee on Judicial Conduct and Disability **only if** one or more members of judicial council dissented from judicial council order (Rule 21(b)(1)(B))

complainant or subject judge may petition for review by Committee on Judicial Conduct and Disability (Rule 21(b)(1)(A))
