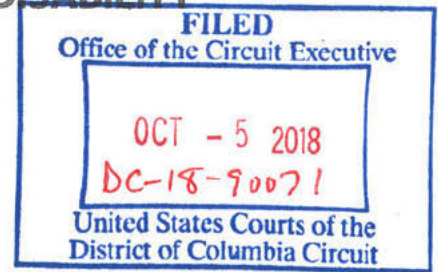

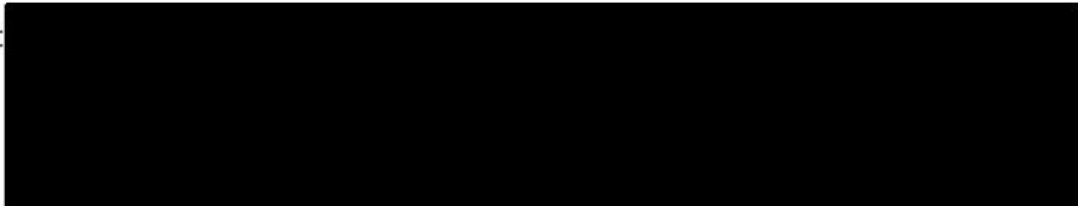

JUDICIAL MISCONDUCT COMPLAINT

Re: Judge Brett Kavanaugh

On September 27, 2018, I watched the televised proceedings of the U.S. Senate Judiciary Committee concerning the nomination of Judge Kavanaugh as an Associate Justice to the Supreme Court of the United States. While watching his testimony I concluded that he is not fit to serve as a federal circuit judge and certainly not as a justice on the Supreme Court. The rules of conduct apply not only to a sitting federal circuit judge but also to a nominee for judicial office.

Judge Kavanaugh testified in a manner that was rude, aggressive, disrespectful, and exhibited a partisan political bias that was undignified for a federal circuit judge. He failed to maintain the high standards of conduct required to uphold the integrity and independence of the judiciary.

During his testimony, Judge Kavanaugh attacked every single senator that is a member of the Democratic Party. He violated the rules prohibiting misconduct and bringing shame and discrediting the judiciary. He yelled and screamed at individual senators, accused them of orchestrating a "political hit job" on him, interrupted senators that were asking reasonable questions, and mocked and belittled senators who were questioning him about his past and present alcohol abuse. He acted in a manner that was wholly undignified and disrespectful.

I believe that Judge Kavanaugh during his testimony violated Canons 1, 2A, and 2C of the Rules For Judicial Conduct established for federal judges. His conduct brought discredit to the robes he wears and made it clear he is not and will never be an impartial judge.

Additionally, it is my belief that there is credible evidence submitted under oath at the hearing by a victim of sexual assault that Judge Kavanaugh was the perpetrator.

It was shameful performance by a federal circuit judge focused on securing a lifetime appointment of power. Do your job and investigate and sanction this judge. If you fail to do so, the public will forever view this court and all others with contempt. Shame on Brett Kavanaugh.
