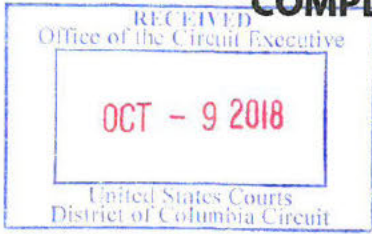

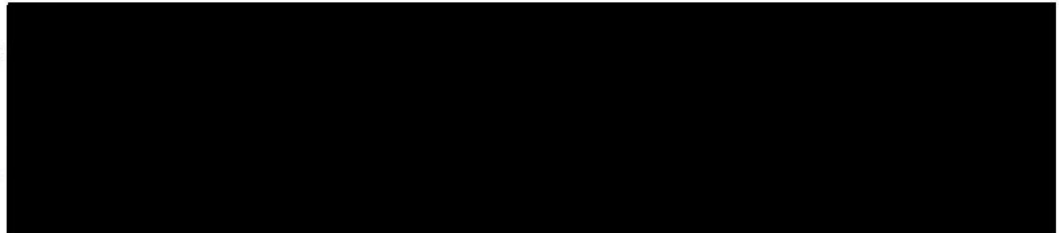

**COMPLAINT OF JUDICIAL MISCONDUCT
AGAINST JUDGE BRETT M. KAVANAUGH**

I would like to file a formal complaint against Judge Brett M. Kavanaugh based upon the hearing before the Senate Judiciary Committee on Thursday, September 27, 2018. Please see the proceedings of the hearing which is available from C-span.

I watched the hearing in its entirety. Judge Kavanaugh's behavior during the aforementioned hearing was both unprofessional and unacceptable, especially given his standing as a Judge for the U.S. Court of Appeals. His disrespectful remarks towards Senators of the U.S. Congress were both blatant and appeared to be an attempt to intimidate some members of the Committee. Whether his rants in his opening statement were simply showmanship or truly reflected a lack of self control, the behavior he exhibited was not worthy of anyone, much less someone sitting as a Judge. I seriously doubt that Judge Kavanaugh would have allowed such behavior in his courtroom at any time – whether from parties, witnesses or attorneys.

Furthermore, based upon his testimony and refusal to directly answer questions regarding his drinking habits in high school and college, Judge Kavanaugh was displaying a callous disregard for the purpose of the hearing and was attempting to mislead the members of the Judiciary Committee as well as every American citizen watching and listening to his testimony. On several occasions he adamantly stated that there were four statements obtained from witnesses under "penalty of felony" which supported his claims on innocence. He deliberately mischaracterized the contents of those statements. He knowingly misrepresented that the statement by Leland Keyser did not exonerate him and failed to mention that she stated she believed Dr. Blasey Ford. (While it is my understanding that the statement by Mark Judge was not actually signed by Mr. Judge, I have been unable to confirm that is accurate.)

I cannot attest to the truth of the allegations against Judge Kavanaugh but his exhibition before the Senate Judiciary Committee and those who were watching and listening to the proceedings indicated a lack of respect, a serious lack of judgment and conveyed the impression that Judge Kavanaugh does not have the self-control and impartiality expected from a Judge in his position.

I would respectfully request that the Judicial Council of the District of Columbia Circuit investigate this Complaint and take the appropriate actions with respect to my Complaint. I would appreciate acknowledgment of the receipt of this Complaint as well as being kept informed of the status of this Complaint. Thank you for the attention to this very serious matter.
