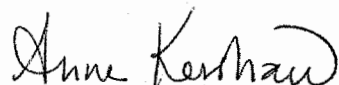
Re: Written Statement of Testimony for New York Hearings regarding Proposed
Federal Rule of Evidence 502

Dear Mr. McCabe:

Thank you for your January 5, 2007 letter accepting my request to testify on January 29, 2007 regarding proposed FRE 502. This letter responds to the committee's request for a written statement of my expected testimony.

The Committee states in the proposed rule that it is interested in any statistical or anecdotal evidence tending to show that limiting the scope of waiver will promote cooperation with government regulators. We are endeavoring to solicit this information from large corporations by way of a small, informal, confidential survey which we are conducting primarily through telephone interviews with internal corporate lawyers. Our hope is to provide the results of this survey to the Advisory Committee through my testimony. We would then follow up with a full written report before the February 15, 2007 close of the comment period. Regrettably, we simply are not far along enough in our survey to provide a full submission at this time.
