I would suggest the rule be changed and the time for filing a 2016(b) statement be shortened to require it at the time of the petition instead of 14 days later.

Where the agreement and compensation have both occurred prior to filing, with the advent of efiling, and the distinct possibility

the 2016(b) may never be filed if the case is dismissed for the lack of some other document, a change in the rule would be

helpful and allow the matter to be brought to the Court's attention when the case has not yet been dismissed and more likely lead

toward full disclosure by attorneys for debtors.
