Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990

Report of Motions Pending More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted More Than Six Months, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months, Social Security Appeal Cases Pending More Than Six Months, and Civil Cases Pending More Than Three Years on

September 30, 2004

Introduction

The Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990 (CJRA) requires the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts (AO), under Section 476 of Title 28, to prepare a semiannual report showing, by U.S. district judge and magistrate judge, all motions pending more than six months, all bench trials that have remained undecided more than six months, and all civil cases pending more than three years. The reporting requirements under the CJRA are designed to help reduce both costs and delays in civil litigation in the district courts. The information also may be used to evaluate demands on the district courts' resources.

This is the 27th semiannual report prepared pursuant to the CJRA that shows all motions in civil cases pending more than six months, civil bench trials submitted more than six months, and civil cases pending more than three years. In accordance with 1998 Judicial Conference mandates, this report now also presents data on bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months and Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months.

The CJRA report is prepared primarily by automated means, mostly through the use of the Integrated Case Management System/CJRA Statistical Reporting Program (ICMS/CJRA) and the Case Management/Electronic Case Files System (CM/ECF). As a result, pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases are being reported in a standardized and consistent fashion, and all judges using these systems have the most accurate tools to help them prepare semiannual reports.

For the CJRA report for September 30, 2004, a total of 93 of the 94 U.S. district courts used the AO's national ICMS/CJRA, CM/ECF, or simulations of these systems to report all pending civil matters; one district court used a combination of manual and personal computer-based procedures to report its matters.

Appendix A provides data for each U.S. district judge and U.S. magistrate judge on motions pending, bench trials submitted, cases pending, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeal cases pending. The CJRA requires the AO Director to establish uniform standards for determining when a motion, bench trial, case, or bankruptcy appeal is "pending"; Appendix B lists these definitions. Status codes for motions pending, bench trials submitted, cases pending, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeal cases pending, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeal cases pending appear in Appendix C. A list of nature of suit codes used in civil litigation appears in Appendix D.

Along with the semiannual consolidated national report, the AO prepares a supplemental report, A Report on Motions Pending for More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted for More Than Six Months, Civil Cases Pending Three Years or More, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending for More Than Six Months, and Social Security Appeal Cases Pending on September 30, 2004, which provides detailed information regarding the individual cases, motions, bench trials, and appeals pending in the U.S. district courts. This document is available to the public through the U.S. district courts, the executive offices of the U.S. courts of appeals, and the AO.

Report Findings

The information in this report presents what may best be described as a "snapshot" of motions pending more than six months, bench trials submitted more than six months, civil cases pending more than three years, and bankruptcy appeals and Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months on September 30, 2004. District judge and magistrate judge caseloads change constantly, so many of the matters pending on September 30, 2004, have since been decided or transferred to other judges. Those using reports of this type thus should take into account the state of change in the district courts' pending caseloads.

Although the information provided in this report pertains to the pending civil caseload of district judges and magistrate judges, readers should take into consideration the overall case processing demands placed on the courts by both civil and criminal matters. An accurate assessment of the demands placed on the district courts also requires consideration of numerous factors such as vacant judgeships and the effects of all cases making up each court's caseload.

Methodology

The CJRA national report is designed to place special emphasis on detailed analyses that are extracted from the national CM/ECF and ICMS/CJRA systems or obtained by other automated means. Each U.S. district court is required to analyze the reasons for delays in disposing of pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases. Judges may use numerous status codes to explain their reasons for delays in these matters. Currently, 30 such status codes are available for CJRA statistical reporting. More specific information about motions pending, bench trials submitted, and cases pending on March 31, 2004, and September 30, 2004, appears in Tables 1, 2, and 3. Figures 1 and 2 illustrate reasons for delay for pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases attributed to district judges and magistrate judges during these reporting periods.

Numbers of Motions Pending, Bench Trials Submitted, Cases Pending, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending, and Social Security Appeal Cases Pending on September 30, 2004.

Motions. The total number of motions pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges declined 11 percent (down 1,038 motions) from 9,920 on March 31, 2004, to 8,882 on September 30, 2004. Pending motions for district judges fell 9 percent to 8,111 (down 820 motions) from the total for March 31, 2004. A total of 771 referrals of motions (down 218 motions) were made to magistrate judges from district judges. Ninety-one percent of all motions pending were before district judges, and 9 percent were before magistrate judges.

For the September 30, 2004, CJRA report, seven circuits reported decreases in pending motions, and five circuits reported increases. The most significant declines in pending motions occurred in the Fifth Circuit (down 402 motions), the Eleventh Circuit (down 332 motions), the Tenth Circuit (down 324 motions), the District of Columbia (down 272 motions), and the First Circuit (down 149 motions). The national decline in pending motions signifies a continuing trend in disposing of motions more effectively in various types of cases in the federal Judiciary. The large decrease in motions in the Fifth Circuit stemmed mostly from declines of more than 40 motions each in the Southern District of Mississippi, the Western District of Louisiana, the Northern District of Texas, and the Southern District of Texas. In the Eleventh Circuit, motions fell by at least 35 each in the Southern District of Florida, the Middle District of Alabama, the Southern District of Alabama, and the Middle District of Florida. In the Tenth Circuit, the District of New Mexico, the Northern District of Oklahoma, and the District of Colorado each reported reductions of more than 60 motions. The District of Columbia's pending motions fell by 272. In the First Circuit, the District of Puerto Rico reported 105 fewer motions over numerous types of cases.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Motions. District courts provided status codes for delays in each of the 8,882 motions (see Appendix C) reported on September 30, 2004. The majority of these codes (62 percent) were in the following nine categories: opinion/ decision in draft (2,016 motions); referred to a magistrate judge (621 motions); decided after the end of the reporting period (587 motions); heavy criminal and civil caseload (568 motions); complexity of case (469 motions); awaiting materials (380 motions); voluminous briefs/transcripts to be read (321 motions); hearing on motion necessary (287 motions); and recently received from the calendar of another judge (249 motions).



Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Motions. The majority of the nature of suit codes provided by district courts for pending motions during the September 30, 2004, reporting period were in the following seven groupings of civil cases: civil rights (2,056 motions); prisoner petitions (1,471 motions); contracts (1,305 motions); personal injury (621 motions), labor suits (566 motions); intellectual property rights (521 motions); and environmental matters (126 motions).

Bench Trials. The total number of bench trials pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges fell by 199 bench trials from 277 on March 31, 2004, to 78 on September 30, 2004. Of these bench trials, district judges reported 81 percent (63 bench trials), and magistrate judges reported 19 percent (15 bench trials). The Southern District of Florida disposed of 184 bench trials related to land condemnation between March 31, 2004, and September 30, 2004. The only other circuits that reported 10 or more pending bench trials were the Ninth Circuit (11 trials), Eleventh Circuit (11 trials), First Circuit (11 trials), and Third Circuit (10 trials).

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bench Trials. The primary status code provided to indicate the reason for delay in pending bench trials on September 30, 2004, was opinion in draft (29 trials).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Bench Trials. District courts provided nature of suit codes for each of the 78 pending bench trials to indicate reasons for delays. Fortynine percent of these codes were related to contract actions (21 trials), patent cases (10 trials), and Employee Retirement Income Security Act cases (6 trials).

Three-Year-Old Cases. The number of civil cases pending more than three years rose 2 percent (up 416 cases) from 18,280 on March 31, 2004, to 18,696 on September 30, 2004. District judges reported 98 percent of all pending three-year-old cases; magis-trate judges reported the remaining 2 percent. The rise in three-year-old cases resulted from increases in 9 of the 12 circuits. The most substantial numerical increases occurred in the Second Circuit (up 245 cases) and the Fifth Circuit (up 121 cases). Three-year-old cases involving a variety of types of cases increased by 214 in the Southern District of New York. The Eastern District of Louisiana reported 110 three-year-old cases, most of them consisting of multidistrict litigation involving product liability. Forty-two percent of all three-year-old cases pending on September 30, 2004 (more than 7,800), involved oil refinery explosions in the Middle District of Louisiana; these cases currently are assigned to a judge pending settlement activity.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Three-Year-Old Cases. District courts provided status codes in all 18,696 cases to indicate the reasons for delays in three-year-old cases. The majority of status codes used (72 percent) fell into the following eight categories: complexity of case (8,385 cases); multidistrict litigation case (1,298 cases); referred to magistrate judge (877 cases); trial scheduled (782 cases); opinion in draft (665 cases); awaiting materials (561 cases); settlement pending (521 cases); and set for status conference (371 cases).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes In Pending Three-Year-Old Cases. Most of the nature of suit codes used for the 18,696 pending three-year-old cases fell into the following seven groupings: personal injury (9,516 cases); prisoner petitions (2,208 petitions); civil rights



(1,706 cases); land condemnation (1,002 cases); contracts (980 cases); intellectual property (381 cases); and labor cases (343 cases).

Bankruptcy Appeals. Bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months increased by 55 appeals on September 30, 2004, to 313. All bankruptcy appeals were reported by district judges. Six circuits reported increases in bankruptcy appeals, five circuits had decreases, and appeals in one circuit remained unchanged. The following six circuits reported 84 percent (264 appeals) of all pending bankruptcy appeals: the Third Circuit (87 appeals), the Second Circuit (66 appeals), the Ninth Circuit (41 appeals), the Eleventh Circuit (29 appeals), the Sixth Circuit (21 appeals), and the Seventh Circuit (20 appeals). The largest growth in pending bankruptcy appeals occurred in the District of Delaware, where appeals rose by more than 40.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bankruptcy Appeals. District courts provided status codes for each of the 313 pending bankruptcy appeals to indicate reasons for delays. Sixty-two percent of these codes fell into the following seven categories: opinion/ decision in draft (54 appeals); voluminous brief/transcripts to be read (35 appeals); recently received from the calendar of another judge (28 appeals); awaiting materials (26 appeals); decided after the end of the reporting period (21 appeals); complexity of case (20 appeals); and heavy criminal and civil caseload (11 appeals).

Social Security Appeal Cases. Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months declined 27 percent (down 249 appeal cases) to 658 on September 30, 2004. District judges reported 76 percent of these appeal cases, and magistrate judges reported the remaining 24 percent. Ten circuits reported decreases, but the pending caseloads in two circuits remained unchanged. The Second, Ninth, Third, and Fourth Circuits, which each reported more than 50 appeals, accounted for 70 percent of the national pending Social Security appeal caseload. The national drop in pending Social Security appeals cases is consistent with the reduction in filings of such cases over the past two years.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Social Security Appeal Cases. District courts provided status codes for all 658 pending Social Security appeal cases. Seventy percent of these codes fell into the following six categories: referred to magistrate judge (162 cases); opinion/decision in draft (117 cases); awaiting materials (71 cases); heavy criminal and civil caseload (52 cases); recently received from the calendar of another judge (35 cases); and decided after the end of the reporting period (26 cases).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Social Security Appeal Cases. Of all nature of suit codes provided for Social Security appeal cases, 93 percent (615 cases) were related to disability insurance or supplemental security income.

Appendix B. Definitions

All active and senior district court judges, as well as all full-time and part-time magistrate judges, must report pending matters. Detailed guidelines for making reports under the CJRA on pending motions, bench trials, and cases appear in the AO's Guide to Judiciary Policies and Procedures (see Volume III-A (Judges Manual), Chapter IV of Section D and Volume XI (Statistics Manual). Several issues relevant to the reporting of cases pending for more than three years include the following.

• With respect to cases pending for more than three years that have been assigned to district judges and magistrate judges from outside the districts where the cases originated, such cases are included in the totals for the districts where they were filed initially. Sometimes a block of cases or a class of cases that are similar in nature is assigned to a single judge. Such cases often require lengthy litigation when they involve complex issues and large numbers of parties.

• This report includes some asbestos cases. The Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation (MDL) authorized the transfer of most of the pending asbestos personal injury/product liability cases to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania under Order Number 875. Asbestos cases that have remained in the districts where they were filed originally or that were transferred back to the original districts are included in this report. However, those cases transferred according to MDL Docket 875 are excluded. All other MDL cases are included in this report.

Cases Pending More Than Three Years. The CJRA requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of cases pending more than three years in the district courts. A case becomes pending as of the date the case originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was reopened, whichever is later. If a case has not been disposed of within three years after its filing date or reopening date, the case shall be reported as pending for more than three years.

Motions Pending More Than Six Months. The CJRA mandates a report enumerating all motions that have been pending for six months or longer. A motion is a request made to a district judge or magistrate judge for an order, ruling, or similar determination. The opposing party has 30 days from the date of a motion's filing to respond to it. A motion becomes pending 30 days after the date it was filed or was referred to a magistrate judge, whichever is later. If no decision on a motion has been filed within six months after the date the motion became pending, and the motion has not been referred to a magistrate judge, the motion shall be reported as pending for more than six months before the presiding judge. If a motion for, or dispose of, the motion within six months after the date the motion became pending for more than six months before the presiding judge. If a motion for, or dispose of, the motion within six months after the date the motion became pending and the date the motion became pending, or the motion shall be reported as pending for both the district judge and the magistrate judge.

Bench Trials Submitted More than Six Months. The CJRA requires the AO to prepare a report of bench trials submitted for more than six months. In a bench trial, the judge (rather than a jury) decides the facts of the case. A bench trial is considered to be submitted on the date the courtroom proceedings are concluded. If a judge fails to file an opinion within six months after a bench trial was submitted, the bench trial shall be reported as submitted for more than six months.

Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months. In accordance with an action of the March 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of bankruptcy appeals pending for more than six months in the district courts. A bankruptcy appeal becomes pending as of the date the appeal originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was

reopened, whichever is later. If an appeal has not been disposed of within six months plus 60 days after its filing date or reopening date, the appeal shall be reported as pending for more than six months.

Social Security Appeal Cases Pending More Than Six Months. In accordance with an action of the September 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of Social Security appeal cases pending for more than six months in the district courts. A Social Security appeal case becomes pending as of the date of the filing of the latest transcript in such case. If a case has not been disposed of within six months plus 120 days after its filing date, the case shall be reported as pending for more than six months.
