Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990

Report of Motions Pending More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted More Than Six Months, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months, Social Security Appeal Cases Pending More Than Six Months, and Civil Cases Pending More Than Three Years on March 31, 2006

Introduction

The Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990 (CJRA) requires the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts (AO), under 28 U.S.C. 476, to prepare a semiannual report showing, by U.S. district judge and magistrate judge, all motions pending more than six months, all bench trials that have remained undecided more than six months, and all civil cases pending more than three years. The reporting requirements under the CJRA are designed to help reduce both costs and delays in civil litigation in the district courts. The information also may be used to evaluate demands on the district courts' resources.

This is the 30th semiannual report prepared pursuant to the CJRA that shows all motions in civil cases pending more than six months, civil bench trials submitted more than six months, and civil cases pending more than three years. In accordance with the Judicial Conference mandates of 1998, this report also presents data on bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months and Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months.

The CJRA report is prepared primarily by automated means, mostly through the use of the Integrated Case Management System/CJRA Statistical Reporting Program (ICMS/CJRA) and the Case Management/Electronic Case Files System (CM/ECF). As a result, pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases are being reported in a standardized and consistent fashion, and all judges using these systems have the most accurate tools to help them prepare semiannual reports.

For the CJRA report for March 31, 2006, a total of 93 of the 94 U.S. district courts used the AO's national ICMS/CJRA, CM/ECF, or simulations of these systems to report all pending civil matters; one district court used a combination of manual and personal computer-based procedures to report its matters.

Appendix A provides data for each U.S. district judge and U.S. magistrate judge on motions pending, bench trials submitted, cases pending, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeal cases pending. The CJRA requires the AO Director to establish uniform standards for determining when a motion, bench trial, case, or bankruptcy appeal is "pending"; Appendix B lists these definitions. Status codes for motions pending, bench trials submitted, cases pending, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appear in Appendix C. A list of nature of suit codes used in civil litigation appears in Appendix D.

Along with the semiannual consolidated national report, the AO prepares a supplemental report, A Report on Motions Pending for More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted for More Than Six Months, Civil Cases Pending Three Years or More, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending for *More Than Six Months, and Social Security Appeal Cases Pending on March 31, 2006,* which provides detailed information regarding the individual cases, motions, bench trials, and appeals pending in the U.S. district courts. This document is available to the public through the U.S. district courts, the executive offices of the U.S. courts of appeals, the AO, and the Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) system.

Report Findings

The information in this report presents what may best be described as a "snapshot" of motions pending more than six months, bench trials submitted more than six months, civil cases pending more than three years, and bankruptcy appeals and Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months on March 31, 2006. District judge and magistrate judge caseloads change constantly, so many of the matters pending on March 31, 2006, have since been decided or transferred to other judges. Those using reports of this type thus should take into account the state of change in the district courts' pending caseloads.

Although the information provided in this report pertains to the pending civil caseload of district judges and magistrate judges, readers should take into consideration the overall case processing demands placed on the courts by both civil and criminal matters. An accurate assessment of the demands placed on the district courts also requires consideration of numerous factors, including vacant judgeships and the effects of all cases making up each court's caseload.

Methodology

While this report is designed to place special emphasis on detailed analyses that are extracted from the national CM/ECF or ICMS/CJRA system, or obtained by other automated means, the analyses of overall data for the nation for March 31, 2006, do not include data for the Eastern District of Louisiana (LA-E). This district was exempted from CJRA reporting for September 30, 2005, as a result of the exceptional disruption to court operations caused by Hurricane Katrina. In this report, data for LA-E for March 31, 2006, have been excluded from the comparative national analyses, but appear separately in Appendix E.

Each U.S. district court is required to analyze the reasons for delays in disposing of pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases. Judges may use numerous status codes to explain their reasons for delays in these matters. Currently, 30 such status codes are available for CJRA statistical reporting. More specific information about motions pending, bench trials submitted, cases, and bankruptcy appeals pending on September 30, 2005, and March 31, 2006, appears in Tables 1, 2, and 3. Figures 1 and 2 illustrate reasons for delay for pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases attributed to district judges and magistrate judges during these reporting periods.

Numbers of Motions Pending, Bench Trials Submitted, Cases Pending, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending, and Social Security Appeal Cases Pending on March 31, 2006.

Motions. The total number of motions pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges decreased 9 percent (down 778 motions) from 8,723 on September 30, 2005, to 7,945 on March 31, 2006. Pending motions for district judges fell 8 percent (down 658 motions) from the total for September 30, 2005, to 7,258. Referrals of motions to magistrate judges from district judges dropped to 687 (down 120 motions). Ninety-one percent of all motions pending were before district judges, and 9 percent were before magistrate judges.

For the March 31, 2006, CJRA report, seven circuits reported declines in pending motions, and five circuits reported increases. The most significant decreases in pending motions occurred in the Tenth Circuit (down 634 motions), the Sixth Circuit (down 150 motions), and the Eleventh Circuit (down 129 motions). In the Tenth Circuit, two judges in the Northern District of Oklahoma disposed of 527 motions. One judge disposed of 296 motions, most of them related to securities, commodities, and exchange cases. The other judge disposed of 157 motions involving a multitude of case types. In the Sixth Circuit, sharp declines in motions in a variety of cases in the Southern District of Ohio (down 79 motions) and the Eastern District of Michigan (down 78 motions) were the primary reasons for the circuit's total decrease. In the Eleventh Circuit, the Northern District of Alabama disposed of 124 motions in different types of cases, with two judges' combining efforts to settle matters in over half of these cases. Smaller reductions in pending motions in many types of cases were reported in the Seventh Circuit, the Fifth Circuit, the District of Columbia Circuit, and First Circuit.



Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Motions. District courts provided status codes for each of the 7,945 motions reported on March 31, 2006 (see Appendix C). The majority of these codes (64 percent) were in the following 10 categories: opinion/decision in draft (1,697 motions), complexity of case (535 motions), referred to magistrate judge (568 motions), heavy criminal and civil caseload (629 motions), hearing on motion necessary (397 motions), decided after the end of the reporting period (340 motions), settlement pending (243 motions), awaiting materials (236 motions), recently received from the calendar of another judge (226 motions), and voluminous brief/transcripts to be read (202 motions).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Motions. The majority of the nature of suit codes provided by district courts for pending motions for March 31, 2006, were for the following six types of civil cases: civil rights (2,032 motions), prisoner petitions (1,256 motions), contract (1,138 motions), intellectual property rights (739 motions), labor (541 motions), and personal injury (487 motions),

Bench Trials. The total number of bench trials pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges increased 3 percent (up 3 trials) from 111 bench trials on September 30, 2005, to 114 on March 31, 2006. Of these bench trials, district judges reported 87 percent of the total (99 trials), and magistrate judges reported 13 percent (15 trials). Increases involving many types of civil cases in the Ninth Circuit (up 15 trials) and Eleventh Circuit (up 8 trials) led these circuits to report the largest jumps in pending bench trials.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bench Trials. District courts provided status codes for each of the 114 pending bench trials to indicate reasons for delays. Sixty-five percent of these cases fell in the following six categories: opinion/decision in draft (37 trials), complexity of case (18 trials), awaiting materials (7 trials), heavy criminal and civil caseload (5 trials), settlement pending (3 trials), and voluminous brief/transcripts to be read (4 trials).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Bench Trials. The nature of suit codes used most often involved the following six types of cases: contract (16 trials), civil rights (16 trials), personal injury (11 trials), land condemnation (14 trials), intellectual property rights (8 trials), and labor (6 trials).

Three-Year-Old Cases. The number of civil cases pending more than three years rose 8 percent (up 1,482 cases) from 19,062 on September 30, 2005, to 20,544 on March 31, 2006. District judges reported 98 percent of all pending three-year-old cases, and magistrate judges reported the remaining 2 percent. Increases in three-year-old cases of many types occurred in 6 of the 12 circuits. The most substantial growth arose in the Eighth Circuit (up 1,666 cases), where a single judge in the District of Minnesota received 1,653 personal injury/product liability cases related to anticholesterol drugs.



Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Three-Year-Old Cases. District courts provided status codes in all 20,544 cases to indicate the reasons for delays in three-year-old cases. The majority of status codes used (81 percent) fell into the following 10 categories: recently received from the calendar of another judge (7,868), multidistrict litigation case (3,122 cases), complexity of case (1,630 cases), referred to magistrate judge (963 cases), trial scheduled (818 cases), opinion/decision in draft (543 cases), awaiting materials (508 cases), settlement pending (481 cases), set for status conference (371 cases), and extensive discovery involved (318 cases).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes In Pending Three-Year-Old Cases. Most of the nature of suit codes used for the 20,544 pending three-year-old cases fell into the following seven groupings: personal injury (11,261 cases), prisoner petitions (2,356 petitions), civil rights (1,580 cases), contract (990 cases), land condemnation (689 cases), intellectual property rights (403 cases), and labor (383 cases).

Bankruptcy Appeals. Bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months declined by 44 appeals from 316 on September 30, 2005, to 272 on March 31, 2006. All but one of the pending bankruptcy appeals were reported by district judges. Five of the 12 circuits

reported decreases in pending bankruptcy appeals, 6 had increases, and the total for 1 remained unchanged. Eighty-one percent of all pending bankruptcy appeals (221 appeals) occurred in five circuits: the Second Circuit (73 appeals), the Ninth Circuit (65 appeals), the Third Circuit (37 appeals), the Sixth Circuit (24 appeals), and the Eleventh Circuit (22 appeals).

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bankruptcy Appeals. District courts provided status codes for each of the 272 pending bankruptcy appeals to indicate reasons for delays. Sixty-six percent of these codes fell into the following eight categories: awaiting materials (48 appeals), opinion/decision in draft (41 appeals), voluminous brief/transcripts to be read (23 appeals), complexity of case (22 appeals), heavy criminal and civil caseload (20 appeals), hearing on motion necessary (12 appeals), decided after the end of the reporting period (7 appeals), and settlement pending (6 appeals).

Social Security Appeal Cases. Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months rose 1 percent (up 7 appeal cases) from 599 on September 30, 2005, to 606 on March 31, 2006. District judges reported 85 percent of these appeal cases, and magistrate judges reported 15 percent. Six of the 12 circuits reported increases, 5 reported decreases, and the total for 1 remained unchanged. Five circuits reported 40 or more Social Security appeals. The national drop in Social Security pending appeals cases is consistent with the reduction in filings of such cases over the past three years.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Social Security Appeal Cases. District courts provided status codes for all 606 pending Social Security appeal cases. Eighty-three percent of these codes fell into the following nine categories: referred to magistrate judge (209 appeal cases), opinion/decision in draft (93 appeal cases), awaiting materials (60 appeal cases), recently received from magistrate judge on recommendation (37 appeal cases), voluminous brief/transcripts to be read (32 appeal cases), heavy criminal and civil caseload

(28 appeal cases), assigned to new judge (18 appeal cases), decided after the end of the reporting period (12 appeal cases), and demands of criminal docket (11 appeal cases).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Social Security Appeal Cases. Ninety-four percent of the nature of suit codes provided for pending Social Security appeal cases (576 cases) were related to disability insurance or supplemental security income.

Appendix B. Definitions

All active and senior district court judges, as well as all full-time and part-time magistrate judges, must report pending matters. Detailed guidelines for making reports under the CJRA on pending motions, bench trials, and cases appear in the AO's *Guide to Judiciary Policies and Procedures* (see Volume III-A (Judges Manual), Chapter IV of Section D and Volume XI (Statistics Manual). Several issues relevant to the reporting of cases pending for more than three years include the following.

• With respect to cases pending for more than three years that have been assigned to district judges and magistrate judges from outside the districts where the cases originated, such cases are included in the totals for the districts where they were filed initially. Sometimes a block of cases or a class of cases that are similar in nature is assigned to a single judge. Such cases often require lengthy litigation when they involve complex issues and large numbers of parties.

• This report includes some asbestos cases. The Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation (MDL) authorized the transfer of most of the pending asbestos personal injury/product liability cases to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania under Order Number 875. Asbestos cases that have remained in the districts where they were filed originally or that were transferred back to the original districts are included in this report. However, those cases transferred according to MDL Docket 875 are excluded. All other MDL cases are included in this report.

Cases Pending More Than Three Years. The CJRA requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of cases pending more than three years in the district courts. A case becomes pending as of the date the case originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was reopened, whichever is later. If a case has not been disposed of within three years after its filing date or reopening date, the case shall be reported as pending more than three years.

Motions Pending More Than Six Months. The CJRA mandates a report enumerating all motions that have been pending six months or longer. A motion is a request made to a district judge or magistrate judge for an order, ruling, or similar determination. The opposing party has 30 days from the date of a motion's filing to respond to it. A motion becomes pending 30 days after the date it was filed or was referred to a magistrate judge, whichever is later. If no decision on a motion has been filed within six months after the date the motion became pending, and the motion has not been referred to a magistrate judge, the motion shall be reported as pending more than six months before the presiding judge. If a motion is referred to a magistrate judge, the magistrate judge must file a report and make a recommendation for, or dispose of, the motion within six months after the date the motion became pending after the date the motion became pending.

Bench Trials Submitted More than Six Months. The CJRA requires the AO to prepare a report of bench trials submitted more than six months. In a bench trial, the judge (rather than a jury) decides the facts of the case. A bench trial is considered to be submitted on the date the courtroom proceedings are concluded. If a judge fails to file an opinion within six months after a bench trial was submitted, the bench trial shall be reported as submitted more than six months.

Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months. In accordance with an action of the March 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months in the district courts. A bankruptcy appeal becomes pending as of the date the appeal originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was re-

opened, whichever is later. If an appeal has not been disposed of within six months plus 60 days after its filing date or reopening date, the appeal shall be reported as pending more than six months.

Social Security Appeal Cases Pending More Than Six Months. In accordance with an action of the September 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months in the district courts. A Social Security appeal case becomes pending as of the date of the filing of the latest transcript in such case. If a case has not been disposed of within six months plus 120 days after its filing date, the case shall be reported as pending more than six months.
