Comments on Amendments to Rules for Judicial-Conduct and Judicial-Disability Proceedings

Comment on Rule 3e: "...judge unable to function effectively." is undefined, subjective, prone to wildly varying interpretation. It is an open invitation for misuse and an opportunity for abuse of authority, especially for the harassment and or dispatch of the subject judge.

Comment on Rule 13a: "....use of appropriate experts..." amounts to granting "fishing: authority with regards to the subject judge; allows expansion of the investigation beyond the original scope.

Singles out the subject judge by the specific request that he/she undergo a medical/psychological examination which is not required uniformly for everyone in similar work.

Amounts to a "fishing" authority , allows expansion of the investigation beyond the original scope.

These amendments open the door to corruption in the form of harassment and blackmail by individuals who for personal and/or political gain may wish to render the subject judge ineffective.
