## Appx. 1K: Required COCP Training by Certification Level

(**Note:** All "CON" required courses are Federal Acquisition Institute (FAI) training courses or equivalent. All judiciary-specific courses are available on JNet Procurement Training page. **See also:** fai.gov.)

- (a) To obtain FAC-C (Professional) certification, all career procurement personnel in the 1102 job series (COCP Professional Level), must:
  - (1) complete four training courses (CON 1100, CON 1200, CON 1300, CON 1400),
  - (2) have at least 12 months of full-time experience applying contracting technical competencies, and
  - (3) pass the contracting professional certification exam.
- (b) Career procurement personnel in the 1102 job series (COCP Professional Level) who were certified at the legacy Federal Acquisition Certification in Contracting (FAC-C) Levels I, II, or III, as of Feb. 1, 2023, were automatically certified as FAC-C (Professional) and are not required to complete the four "CON" training courses (e.g., CON 1100).
